

Varieties



Atlantis...is a 75 day variety. Has a round oval shape, excellent flesh and high sugar content. This is a Deep Orange color on the inside. It has very mild sutures (stripes) on the outside and refined netting.



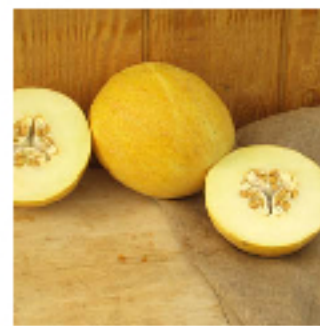
Solstice...is a very large melon with deep sutures and heavy netting on the outside. The flesh has a high sweetness level and this melon stores well.



Minerva...is a 7-8 lb melon with light sutures and heavy netting on the outside. This is similar to the old Athena variety but is slightly larger.



Sugar Cube...baby melons that are an early variety and very high disease resistance. Has medium netting, light sutures. Personal sized melon with deep orange flesh.



Sensation...A unique melon. Excellent taste, texture, sweetness and aroma. When the melons are allowed to fully mature, the flesh will be sweet, pure white and soft. The 5.5-6 lb. fruit have sparse but distinctive netting over green, yellow and orange skin.



Tireno...A bit smaller, but one of the best tasting cantaloupe there is. Medium net, deep green sutures, color is dark orange. Good healthy plants too.



Orange Sherbet...oval, netted with green sutures. A hybrid gourmet type melon. Stores well. Has a high sugar content.



Lambkin...is a personal sized Christmas type melon. Its yellow rind has mottled green and the flesh is sweet, juicy, and aromatic. Fruit is oval shaped and weighs about 2-4lbs. Can be stored for long time.



Sun Jewel...This is an Asian style oblong melon that is sweet when ripe. The flesh is white.



Crenshaw...This is a yellow/green melon on the outside with a smooth skin. The inside of the melon is pale orange.



Morning Ice...This is a honeydew melon. The outside of the melon is smooth pale whitish green. The inside is a pale green color. Sweet.



Lilly...Another crenshaw melon. This is a smooth skinned melon with light orange flesh. The fruit is very sweet.



Salmon Dew...These melons have a smooth white/yellow outside and a pale orange center. They are what we call gourmet melons in the store.
